

xpath

With chromium in developer mode right click on the node ⇒ “Copy XPath”

With lxml and python

```
sudo apt-get install libxml2-dev libxslt1-dev python-dev  
pip install lxml
```

print xpath of all elements

```
from lxml import html, etree  
  
htmltext="bla bla bla"  
  
doc=html.fromstring(htmltext)  
#find_text = doc.xpath("//text()")  
tree=etree.ElementTree(doc)  
for e in tree.iter():  
    print e.text,tree.getpath(e)
```

get element from xpath

```
from lxml import html  
  
htmltext="bla bla bla"  
xpath="/html/body/div/table[2]/tr[1]/td"  
  
doc=html.fromstring(htmltext)  
print doc.xpath(xpath)[0].text
```
